functions and processes, the unique leadership capabilities and vision of the leader or founder.

- **Marketing** – Projects were assigned on Designing the Brand Name, Logo, USP, Design & Style of The Product, Sales Promotion, Advertising, Channels of Distribution.
- **Advertising** - Students created an advertising campaign, which involved writing the brief, determining objectives of the campaign, determining the niche, planning the marketing research, selecting media and making presentations. Presentations on Consumer Goods Advertising, Institutional Advertising, Financial Advertising and Political Advertising, were prepared.
- **Accountancy**- Students prepared computerized assignments on Company Financial statements - Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account along with Schedules.
