The college applied to National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Cycle of Accreditation in the revised framework under the able leadership and guidance of Dr. Santosh Kaul, Principal and Dr. Renuka Devi Jena, IQAC Coordinator. The Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) was submitted by the IQAC on 8<sup>th</sup> September, 2018. The Self Study Report (SSR) was submitted on 6<sup>th</sup> December, 2018. After the successful completion of Data Verification and Validation (DVV) and passing the Pre-Qualification Stage, the Peer Team Visit was scheduled by NAAC.

The NAAC Peer Team visited the college on 30<sup>th</sup> April and 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2019. 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**ENGLISH CC**

**Remedial English**

**English word recognition language game** was conducted in class to make students guess the word and also to active their passive vocabulary as an elementary aspect of remedial coaching on 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2018. BA I students were taught to use English to English especially **Oxford English pocket dictionary** and to identify the part of speech of the word. They were also made familiar with the **online dictionary “define---**” and suggested to use the dictionary at times on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018. A homework of writing 1200 words along with their **antonyms and synonyms** was given on 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 and it was checked on 13<sup>th</sup> July 2018.

**Parts of speech-** noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, adjective, preposition, conjunction, interjection, and articles were taught in detail with examples and were given class work of finding and writing the meaning of 20 words of each part of speech with the help of Oxford English pocket dictionary teaching and exercises were conducted from 5<sup>th</sup> July to 12<sup>th</sup> July 2018 in B.A. I. Homework of writing 20 nouns, verbs, adverbs, and adjectives along with their meanings with the help of an Oxford pocket dictionary was assigned on 14<sup>th</sup> July 2018 and was checked on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2018. Students were taught **tenses** in detail along with **verb Phrases and clauses and types of sentence** as a part of remedial coaching and were given sentences in the class and asked to guess the tense of sentences on the basis of verb phrase. This activity took place between 13<sup>th</sup> July to 19<sup>th</sup> July 2018. Students were assigned homework of writing **three forms of 500 verbs** on 20<sup>th</sup> July 2018 and the concern teacher checked the homework on 11<sup>th</sup> August 2018. They were also given homework of writing hundred sentences of each tense and underline word phrases and was checked by the teacher on 24<sup>th</sup> August 2018.

27<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018 **phonetics activity** was conducted in B.A I students were taught the **44 sounds in English** along with their pronunciation and examples the students were able to pronounce the words correctly with the help of **phonetics transcription** given in the dictionary. This exercise and pronunciation help them to improve spoken English. B.A. I students were also taught **punctuation marks** in detail to make them understand the importance of punctuation marks is a part of remedial coaching class. Class work of writing synonyms and antonyms of 260 words with the help of online dictionary was given on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2018. **Story Telling Activity** was conducted in B.A. I on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2019, all the students selected stories of their own choice.
