











3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can be best described as 189 responses




5. Fairness of the internal evaluation by the teachers


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you? 189 responses














13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing the right level of challenges











19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector,


