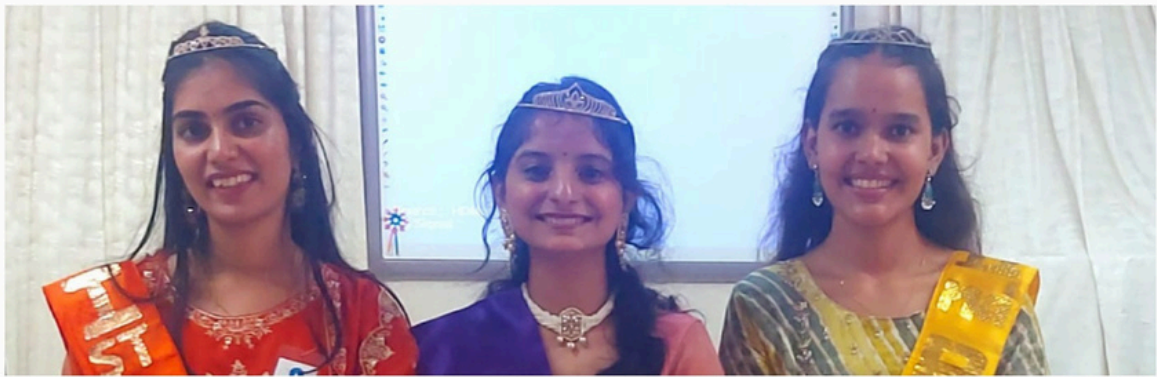


## **15 th JANUARY 2025- MS. "YASHSWINI" CONTEST**

### **17 th JANUARY 2025 -ANNUAL FUNCTION -RUS PHUAR**

Marwadi Sammelan's B. M. Ruia Girls' College, affiliated to the S.N.D.T Women's University, Mumbai, celebrated ***Ras-Phuhar-Lokrang***, an annual day function on 17th January, 2025 at Patkar Hall Auditorium, S.N.D.T Women's University, Mumbai.

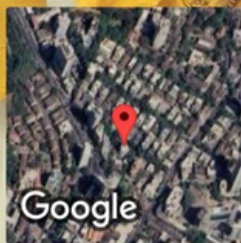
