Ramprasad Poddar Auditorium, B. M. Ruia Girls' College under the MoU Programme. M.Com students from Maniben Nanavati Women's College and M.Com, M.A. B.A (Sociology) students from B. M. Ruia Girls' College attended the guest lecture. The Resource Person, **Dr. Varsha Mallah, Head of Commerce Department, Bhavan's Somani College**, explained about the key elements to be considered while writing a research paper. FACULTY EXCHANGE PROGRAMME UNDER MOU

WORKSHOP ON “USE OF ICT FOR DATA COLLECTION AND INTERPRETATION”

Workshop on “Use of ICT for Data Collection and Interpretation” was organized at Maniben Nanavati Women’s College, Vile Parle West on 25 February, 2019 under the Faculty Exchange MoU Programme with Maniben Nanavati Women's College. Dr.Nooruzia Qazi, Head of Commerce Department, B.M.Ruia Girls’ College, was the Resource person. She spoke about various ICT resources that can be used for data collection and interpretation for research. She explained the procedure to prepare google forms using google account and designing questionnaire for survey with the option of short and long paragraphs, Multiple Choice questions, Check boxes, Rating scale, Multiple Grid options, inserting images, etc. The google forms can be used for data collection and interpretation, as the responses collected can be graphically represented by pie charts, bar graphs, etc. which are instantly prepared in real time and updated as the data is collected. The use of smart phones, laptops, etc for data collection was demonstrated and the students filled a short survey form and were able to see the response immediately on screen and the data was represented in the form of pie charts and graphs. The session was informative and useful for the students.

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GUEST LECTURE ON “MARGINAL COSTING”

A Guest lecture was organized for the M.Com - I students for the Sem II subject Accounting for Managerial Decisions **Topic- “Marginal Costing”** at Maniben Nanavati Women’s College on 26th February, 2019 under the Faculty Exchange MoU Programme. **Dr. Ganatra Kashyap** was the Resource Person for the session. He briefed the students about the concept of Marginal Costing and topics like Contribution, Variable Costs, Fixed Costs, etc. He also spoke about basic fundamentals and applications such as Profit Volume Ratio, Breakeven Point and Margin of Safety. Industry applications of Marginal Costing such as Shutdown or Continue, what if analysis, etc were discussed. Practical examples with adjustments were taken up and the lecture ended with question answer session.

The Institute charged a registration fee of Rs.350/- from the participants.

The session on 'Careers in Capital Market' by Mr. Aamir Sayyad (Academic Associate, NISM) commenced at 10.am. The session helped students in understanding the

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functioning of Capital Market in India. He also explained about the roles of various market intermediaries, various roles the market professionals perform, career opportunities offered by the capital market and better career prospects in financial sector. The simulation session on 'Trading in Stock Market' started at 12.00 pm and was conducted by Dr. Latha Chari (Professor, NISM).

She taught the students how to do live trading in the stock market by entering purchase and sell orders of shares. She made the students understand by giving examples on how the stock prices fluctuate in the market. The hands on experience on trading in stock market was very informative as the students got practical knowledge about the securities market. Out of the 26 students, 2 students who gained highest profit in the virtual trading were awarded as the smart trader. At the end, students received participation certificates from NISM. The session finished by 1.00 pm with a group photograph of students and NISM coordinators. The students enjoyed the sessions which were very informative. They learnt and gained insights about stock market.

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TUTORIALS/ REMEDIAL CLASSES FOR WEAK STUDENTS

Class Tests and solving practical problems for Accounts subject are regularly practiced in class to identify the weak students.

Remedial lectures for weak students are conducted and a separate lecture is allotted to solve doubts and difficulties of students. The Remedial lecture is included in M.Com I and M.Com II Time Table.

Extra lectures are also conducted for students who miss the Accounts lectures due to ill health, job or personal problems. Students who are able to solve accounts problems of higher level of difficulty are identified as advanced learners and more practical problems of higher aptitude are solved with them.

Individual and personal attention is given to students to make sure that they are able to understand the topic, concepts and practice sufficient practical problems in Accounts.

Previous years Question papers are regularly solved in class and students submit assignments based on additional sums and past question papers.

d) VALUE-ADDED COURSES

- **Employability Skills and Career Ready Orientation Program** was organized on 7 August, 2018 by **Antarang Foundation**. The Training Program was
