

### WEBINAR ON 'CONSUMERISM AND FINANCIAL LITERACY IN COVID-19 TIMES' ON DECEMBER 8, 2020

A webinar on 'Consumerism and Financial Literacy in Covid-19 Times' was jointly organized by the Department of Commerce and Department of Sociology on December 8, 2020 in the college through Google Meet platform. Around 140 students attended the webinar.

The Resource Person of the webinar was Financial Advisor Mrs. Archana Bhingarde and Mr.T.R Pandey, Project Manager from Consumer Guidance Society of India. Mrs. Archana Bhingarde welcomed the students and gave them an insight into how to gain wealth prudently as young investors. She addressed the audience about the traditional approach adopted by many investors to increase wealth, such as investments in Gold, Real Estate, Fixed Deposits, etc. She made the audience aware of such investment's failure to yield high returns, in the long run, coupled with problems relating to liquidity.

Citing examples from her own life experience, she revealed her choice of making wise investments at an early stage in her life, which yielded her good returns years later. Therefore, she encouraged the students to look for good investment options in Mutual Funds and Capital Market. She stressed some crucial factors as choosing investment size, tenure of investment, earning potential of the investment, its liquidity to be kept in mind before making wise investments. She also advised the students to make informed choices when investing in Capital Market. She explained the difference between large, mid, and small-cap stocks and spoke about various stock market options for a wise investment.

Lastly, she cautioned students to be careful and not fall prey to dubious schemes by companies or groups who promise high and quick returns in their effort to attract investors. She concluded

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by encouraging students to concentrate on long-term results and make appropriate investments as needed and not by what is offered. She reiterated that students must start investing early in their career to get better returns later in life.

Resource person Mr. T.R Pandey spoke about Consumer Rights and created awareness among students about the Consumer Guidance Society of India(CGSI). Through a well-documented video, he explained the role of CGSI in educating the consumer about their rights, especially when faced with a situation where sellers offer them substandard adulterated foods or charge them exorbitant prices for goods. In some instances, policy claims are not settled at the right time. In real estate deals, there is a delay in getting ownership of the property in some cases. He concluded by asking the students to voice their opinion and concerns and approach CGSI and its various agencies to address their grievances and place their concerns and complaints. Overall, the webinar was very informative and useful. It provided the students the much-needed education about Financial Literacy and their Rights as Consumers under the governance of the Consumer Guidance Society of India.

### WEBINAR ON WEBINAR ON "MANGROVES - DISTRIBUTION, ADAPTATIONS, BIODIVERSITY, AND CONSERVATION" ON DECEMBER 11, 2020

A webinar on "Mangroves - Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation" was jointly organized by the Department of Sociology and Department of Commerce under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2020 in the college through Microsoft Teams platform. Around 125 students attended the webinar.

The Resource Person of the webinar was Mr. Hemant V. Karkhanis, Associate Manager, Mangrove Department, Construction Business Unit of Godrej, and Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. Mr. Hemant welcomed the students and apprised the students about Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation of Mangroves.

He gave insight into the distribution of Mangrove Forests through satellite images of Mangroves in Thane creek. He also highlighted and explained the growth and distribution of these forests across Maharashtra's eastern and western cost through a World Map picture He explained to the audience the adaptations of Mangrove to their habitat. He discussed various varieties of mangroves seen in India, like River Mangroves and Red Mangroves. He explained

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their unique root system, which enables them to spread far and wide. He mentioned the Wax coating on their leaves, which prevents the leaves underwater from decay. He explained how the mother plant holds the new plant at a seed-stage for about two or three months before becoming independent and spreading its root.

He highlighted the various unobvious uses of Mangrove Forest to humankind. He spoke about its fruit, which is edible and used among the fisherfolk community. Its leaves are used as fodder for the cattle in various parts of Maharashtra and Gujarat. The wood of Mangrove forest is highly water-resistant and used by Fisherfolk Community for the construction of Boats. He spoke about its ability to absorb large amounts of pollutants from air and water, thereby creating a clean environment for the community.

He shared videos and images of various wildlife, birds, and insects for whom their presence is useful for feeding, breeding, and nesting. He educated the audience about the mangrove forest under the Coastal Regulatory Zone acquired by Godrej in 1940. The work on conservation carried out to date on the 2000 acres of land. He informed the students about the continuing work at Thane Creek Mangrove area wherein from 1998-2000, Godrej acquired 80 acres of the site and planted 20 lakh saplings of Mangrove.

He expressed concerns over neglecting this vast natural resource that is becoming extinct due to humanity's apathy. He discussed the measures taken by Godrej to educate and create awareness among the masses about mangroves. He spoke about Godrej's dedicated website to protect and preserve mangroves. He shared details about Godrej Mangrove Mobile App that is available in various languages to educate and creating awareness among the masses.

Overall, the webinar was very informative and useful. It provided the students the muchneeded education about distribution, adaptations, biodiversity, and conservation of Mangroves.

#### **GUEST LECTURE ON 'MUTUAL FUNDS' ON DECEMBER 15, 2020**

Department of Commerce and Department of Sociology under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, in association with National Institute of Securities Markets (Established by SEBI), organized a session on 'Mutual Funds' for students on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2020 at 10.30 am. The session was hosted on the online platform Webex, and around 90 participants attended the session. The Resource Person for the session was Mr. Gokulnath Raja, Business Development Manager from the National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM).

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The theme of the session was on understanding the concept and working of Mutual Funds. Mr.

Gokulnath Raja introduced the subject of Mutual Funds with the well-known idiom 'Don't put

all eggs in one basket.' He spoke about the Mutual Fund as a basket where the money collected

from many investors to invest in securities like stocks, bonds, etc., is kept. He highlighted that

while investing, investors must not concentrate all efforts and resources in one area as one

could lose everything, he likened it to all the eggs breaking if it is kept in one basket.

He explained the student's essential concepts of Mutual funds like Net Asset Value, Units,

Open and Close-ended funds with illustrations and examples. He briefed the students on the

functioning of Mutual Funds and introduced them to how mutual funds operate. He spoke about

the different categories of Mutual Fund like Equity, Debt, Sector Equity, ELSS, and Liquid

Funds and their characteristics.

In closing, he introduced the various certification courses offered by NSIM. He elaborated on

the 26 courses offered at their institute. He informed the students that if they wish to be

employed as a relationship manager in any Institution under Financial Markets, they will

require this certification.

The session ended with students participating in College Level Quiz, which had Zonal and

National Level Participation for those who qualified. Overall, the session seemed beneficial as

it created awareness to the students on the topic of Mutual Funds.

PANEL DISCUSSION ON "CEDAW: CONVENTION ON THE ELIMINATION OF

ALL FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN" ON 14<sup>TH</sup> APRIL, 2021

B.M. Ruia Girls' College in collaboration with St. Arnold' College and Swami Vivekananda

College organized a Panel Discussion on "CEDAW: Convention on the elimination of all

forms of Discrimination Against Women" on 14th April, 2021.

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Convention on Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW), adopted in 1979 by the UN General Assembly is an international bill of rights for Women consisting of a preamble and 30 articles.

It defines what constitutes Discrimination against women and sets up an agenda for national action to end such discrimination. India signed CEDAW in July 1980 and ratified it in 1993 with certain reservations.

CEDAW is very important for Youth today because they are the eyes and ears for monitoring whether women and girls rights are being protected. They are able to suggest government, how it can advance with respect to women rights in line with the convention. Three colleges of Mumbai – St. Arnold's Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce, Andheri (East) (affiliated to University of Mumbai), Swami Vivekanand Night College of Arts and Commerce, Dombivali (East) (affiliated to University of Mumbai) and B.M. Ruia Girls' College, Gamdevi (West) (affiliated to SNDT Women's University) came together and organised a Panel Discussion on Online mode.

The programme commenced with Welcome and Introduction by Prof. Sunita Sharma, Principal, St. Arnold's Night Degree College; followed by Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak, Principal, B.M. Ruia Girls' College, and Dr. Anuja N.Palsuledesai, Principal, Swami Vivekananda Night College of Arts and Commerce, briefing about their respective colleges.

The Moderator of the Panel Discussion was Prof. Vibhuti Patel, Former Professor, TISS & SNDTWU, Mumbai.
