DEPARTMENTAL ACTIVITIES

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SEMINARS, WEBINARS, WORKSHOPS AND GUEST LECTURES ORGANIZED

- A Webinar on "Waste Management and Environment Protection" was organized on 5th June 2021, at 10:30 a.m. by the Department of Sociology and Department of Commerce in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell on World Environment Day. The Faculty Members and Students attended this Webinar on the Google Meet Platform. A total of around 100 participants attended the Webinar. Resource Person, Mr. Nikhil Mene, Sub Engineer, Solid Waste Management Department, Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM), informed the audience about the genesis of World Environment Day since its inception in 1974 in United Nations. Finally, he introduced the theme of World Environment Day for the year 2021, "Reimagine, Recreate, Restore." He introduced his session by urging the audience to develop a lifestyle of embracing green habits, which includes avoiding plastics and using cloth bags, saving energy, and saving water, using public transport, planting more trees, segregating dry and wet waste, and preventing the attitude of use. He briefed the audience about MCGM (Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai). He highlighted its role in the Solid Waste Department by adopting certain fixed areas through corporators in different city limits. He spoke about the Solid Waste Management process in the city through a flow chart. He emphasized the importance of segregating dry and wet waste at the grass-root level for increased efficiency at waste treatment sites. He created awareness among the audience about various activities undertaken by MCGM, such as manual street sweeping, which is done for about 253 km a day. In addition, Beach cleaning is done for 36.5 km a day, and their regular work in Swaccha Mumbai Prabodhan Abhiyaan. Through video presentations and real-life examples, he sensitized the audience to think about the future and save the environment from degradation and reckless use of resources.

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

The Student Symposium had six teams - Team Hunar, Passion Pavers, Ethical Unicorn, Maker's Backer's, Helping Hands and Educated Elites comprising of 28 participants. Each team made a presentation on a social cause. They presented a sustainable business model, which would be time line specific and would contribute towards social development of the society. The Jury and the Panelist were – Prof. Samapti Guha – Prof. School of Management and Labour Studies, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. Dr. Manjula Jagatramka – Dean- Textiles, Institute of Heritage Textiles, J J T University, Ms Dipali Mehta, Social Entrepreneur and Prof. Vibhuti Patel, Former Prof. TISS & SNDT University, Mumbai.



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answered. Overall, the Session enlightened the students and created awareness about principles involved in sound financial planning.






• A webinar on 'Consumerism, how to manage Money and be a smart Investor' was jointly organized by the Department of Commerce and Department of Sociology on 10th December 2021 in the college through Google Meet platform around 100 students

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attended the webinar. The Resource Person of the webinar for the first session was Resource person Mr. T.R Pandey (Project Manager-CGSI) he spoke about Consumer Rights and created awareness among students about the Consumer Guidance Society of India (CGSI). He briefed the students that the Consumer Protection Act, 1986 is a social legislation that lays down the rights of the consumers and provides for promotion and protection of the rights of the consumers which has enables ordinary consumers to secure less expensive and often speedy redressal of their grievances. He explained that the Act mandates establishment of Consumer Protection Councils at the Centre as well as in each State and District, with a view to promoting consumer awareness. Through its 3-tier structure of the National and State Commissions and District Commissions for speedy resolution of consumer disputes. The resource person for the second session was Mrs. Madhumita Ghosh Financial Advisor. She briefed the audience about the difference between Saving and Investment emphasizing the need to invest regularly to meet the financial requirements that may arise later in life. She made a differentiation between passive and active income and pointed out the requirement of people once they cross 60 years.
