1. Student Feedback & Action Taken

Key Feedback:

- Students suggested employability courses like Tally and other skill-based training programs.
- Requests for improved infrastructure, including library and computer lab facilities.
- Demand for career guidance sessions and placement training programs.

Action Taken:

- Organized workshops on soft skills, employability skills, and add-on courses.
