डॉ. साही ने डालने वक्तव्य में कबीर और तुलसी के व्यक्तित्व व कृत्तित्व में समानता पर प्रकाश डालते हुए कहा कि दोनों ही भक्त किव हैं किंतु समाज को संदेश देने का दृष्टिकोण अलग-अलग है सन्त कबीर यदि समाज को कड़े शब्दों में फटकार लगाई है तो तुलसी ने रामभक्ति का मार्ग दिखाया है। परन्तु उद्देश्य दोनो का एक ही था और वो था स्वस्थ समाज स्थापना। आज का समाज में भी आदर्शों, मूल्यों का पतन हो रहा है। मानवीयता समाप्त हो रही है, अनासक्ति बढ़ रही है, जाति,धर्म-विभेद मनुष्य-मनुष्य के बीच की दूरियां बढ़ा रहे हैं। इसे देखते हुए कबीर और तुलसी दोनो के काव्य की अत्यंत आवश्यकता है। आज समाज को निडरता से फटकार लगाने वाले कबीर जैसे फक्कड़ सन्त किव की आवश्यकता है तो दूसरी ओर रिश्तों की,मानवता की डोर भक्ति,शांति से पकड़कर राम राज्य की स्थापना का स्वप्न देखनेवाले रामभक्त किव तुलसी भी उतने ही आवश्यक हैं।

डॉ. हिमांशु चतुर्वेदी ने महात्मा गांधी के नारी के प्रति दृष्टिकोण को बताते हुए कहा कि गांधी जी नारी को किसी भी तरह पुरुषों से कम नहीं मानते थे। इस विषय में गांधी जी का स्वयं के कथन की ओर संकेत करते हुए कहा कि बापू कहते थे कि- 'मैं बेटे और बेटियों के साथ बिलकुल एक जैसा व्यवहार करूंगा। जहां तक स्त्रियों के अधिकार का सवाल है, मैं कोई समझौता नहीं करूंगा। नारी पर ऐसा कोई कानूनी प्रतिबंध नहीं लगाना चाहिए जो पुरुषों पर ना लगाया गया हो।' उन्होंने बताया कि गांधी जी महिलाओं को पुरुष की अपेक्षा अधिक शक्तिशाली सहनशील और सुदृण मानते थे। नारी को अबला कहना उनके आत्मस्वाभिमान को चोट पहुंचाना है। डॉ. हिमांशु जी ने कहा कि गांधी जी स्त्री और पुरुष को एक दूसरे का पूरक मानते थे और आपसी सहयोग के बिना दोनों के अस्तित्व पर प्रश्न चिन्ह लग जाता है। इसलिए नारी को समाज में उतना ही सम्मान देना है जितना कि पुरुष को। इस प्रकार गांधी जी के नारी चिंतन को चतुर्वेदी जी अपने वक्तव्य के माध्यम से व्याख्यायित किया।

डॉ. विजय जी ने अपने वक्तव्य में बौद्धिक संपदा के अधिकार पर प्रकाश डालते हुए बताया कि किसी वस्तु या विचार के निर्माताओं को उनकी वस्तु या विचार के निर्माण का संपूर्ण श्रेय जिस अधिकार से प्राप्त होता है उसे बौद्धिक संपदा का अधिकार ('Intellectual Property Rights') कहते हैं,जो निर्माता का सामाजिक दृष्टिकोण से व्यक्तिगत हितों की रक्षा करता है। यह अधिकार किसी आविष्कार एवं सृजनात्मक गतिविधियों के आधार पर प्रदान किया जाता हो। इसके अन्तर्गत पेटेन्ट, औद्योगिक डिजाइन, प्रतिलिप्याधिकार, पादप प्रजनक का अधिकार, एकीकृत परिपथ का ले-आउट या खाका डिजाइन इत्यादि आते हैं। बौद्धिक सम्पदा के वे सभी

अधिकार जो किसी उपभोक्ता को सूचना प्रदान करते हैं। वास्तव में यह मानव मस्तिष्क की उपज है।आई.पी.आर. अधिकारों को सिविल और आपराधिक दोनों तंत्रों द्वारा संरक्षित किया जा सकता है। समाज के सभी वर्गों में बौद्धिक संपदा अधिकारों के आर्थिक-सामाजिक एवं सांस्कृतिक लाभों के प्रति जागरुकता पैदा करना। बौद्धिक संपदा अधिकारों के सृजन को बढ़ावा देना। मजबूत और प्रभावशाली बौद्धिक संपदा अधिकार नियमों को अपनाना, ताकि अधिकृत व्यक्तियों तथा वृहद लोकहित के बीच संतुलन बना रहे। इस तरह बौद्धिक संपदा का अधिकार समाज के लिए अत्यंत उपयोगी एवं महत्वपूर्ण है।

## Report

#### **Remedial English**

- English word recognition language game was conducted in class to make students guess the word and also to active their passive vocabulary as an elementary aspect of remedial coaching. BA I students were taught to use English to English especially Oxford English pocket dictionary and to identify the part of speech of the word. They were also made familiar with the online dictionary "define---" and suggested to use the dictionary at times. A homework of writing 1200 words along with their antonyms and synonyms was given.
- ➤ Parts of speech- noun, pronoun, verb, adverb, adjective, preposition, conjunction, interjection, and articles were taught in detail with examples and were given class work of finding and writing the meaning of 20 words of each part of speech with the help of Oxford English pocket dictionary teaching and exercises were conducted. Homework of writing 20 nouns, verbs, adverbs, and adjectives along with their meanings with the help of an Oxford pocket dictionary was assigned and was checked. Students were taught tenses in detail along with verb Phrases and clauses and types of sentence as a part of remedial coaching. They were also given homework of writing hundred sentences of each tense and underline word phrases.
- ➤ Phonetics activity was conducted in B.A I students were taught the 44 sounds in English along with their pronunciation and examples the students were able to pronounce the words correctly with the help of phonetics transcription given in the dictionary. This exercise and pronunciation help them to improve spoken English. B.A.I students were also taught punctuation marks in detail to make them understand the importance of punctuation marks is a part of remedial coaching class. Class work of writing synonyms and antonyms of 260 words with the help of online dictionary was given. Story Telling Activity was conducted.

➤ Students were introduced to the mobile apps like BBC Learning English, British English Listening, Cambridge 1500 English Conversations, Cambridge Advanced Learners' Dictionary and were motivated to download and use these apps to improve their grammar and vocabulary as well as language skills like listening, speaking, reading and writing skills.







Anyone who's random sugar level is greater than or equal to 160 in the preliminary report, their blood samples will be taken to perform the Hba1c Test to monitor sugar levels during past 60 days.

If the Hba1c test is performed, such a person shall get the report via a link sent through SMS to the mobile number mentioned in the registration form.

Inauguration of Blood Sugar Check up Camp in Association with the Rotary Club of Bombay Queen City. Inaugurated by Rotarian and President Mr. Girish Agarwal.

Details of number of persons checked, included college students and their parents / family members, staff, members of community around college and regular visitors in college such as post office staff. 

NSS PO Ms Swati conducted a quick survey of students to understand the social media behaviour by students.


The findings of the survey were discussed in this workshop. Ms. Sheetal Bidkar also commented about the findings of this survey during her comments.



### PANEL DISCUSSION WITH WOMEN LEADERS Intersectionality between Quality Education, Health and Social Development




All the HEIs in Maharashtra have been assigned the state of Odisha for creating awareness among the citizens of Maharashtra, to begin with our students.


### Similarities between Maharashtra and Odisha

Anyone who's random sugar level is greater than or equal to 160 in the preliminary report, their blood samples will be taken to perform the Hab1c Test to monitor sugar levels during past 60 days.

If the Hab1c test is performed, such a person shall get the report via a link sent through SMS to the mobile number mentioned in the registration form.

Total 608 persons benefitted from the blood sugar check-up camp.

4 persons were found to be diabetic, (3 women and 1 male). The 3 women were knowing that they are diabetic. The male member (24 years) discovered today that he has high sugar. His sugar was 224. He is one of the choreographers of Ras Phuhar, appointed for the annual day event of the college. We did not find any student with high or low blood pressure nor may of the students were found to have low or high blood sugar.

Among 3 women for whom blood sample have been collected for Hba1c and TSH test, 2 are teaching staff and one is from college canteen.




Concerned local authorities in the municipality shall be alerted and will be able to take action.
