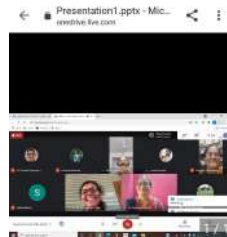

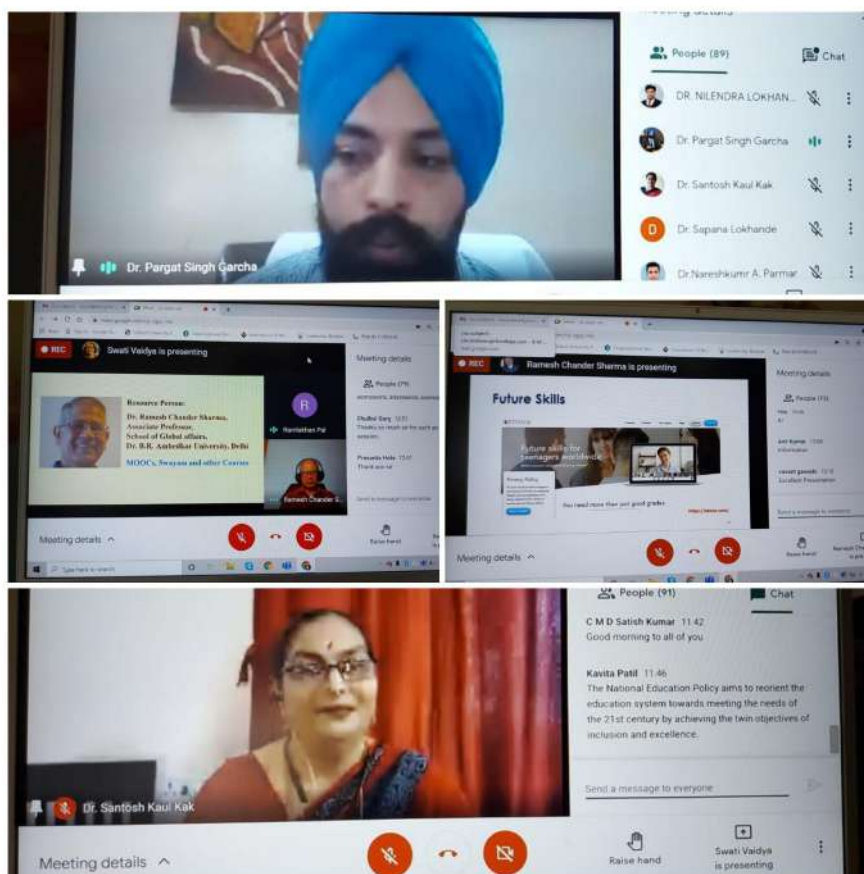

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

Department of Commerce in collaboration with Board of Industry-Academia Partnership (BIAP) conducted an Online Session on “**Investment Awareness**” on November 28, 2020 at 10:30 am to celebrate World Investor Week.

The Resource Person was Mr. Atul Sathe Sir, Assistant Professor in Department of Accountancy from H.R College of Commerce & Economics. More than 100 students and 10 teachers attended the Webinar. The topics included Investor Rights, Stock Market, Impact of Pandemic on the economy, etc.

WEBINAR ON 'CONSUMERISM AND FINANCIAL LITERACY IN COVID-19 TIMES' ON DECEMBER 8, 2020

A webinar on '**Consumerism and Financial Literacy in Covid-19 Times**' was jointly organized by the Department of Commerce and Department of Sociology on December 8, 2020 in the college through Google Meet platform. Around 140 students attended the webinar.

The Resource Person of the webinar was Financial Advisor Mrs. Archana Bhingarde and Mr.T.R Pandey, Project Manager from Consumer Guidance Society of India. Mrs. Archana Bhingarde welcomed the students and gave them an insight into how to gain wealth prudently as young investors. She addressed the audience about the traditional approach adopted by many investors to increase wealth, such as investments in Gold, Real Estate, Fixed Deposits, etc. She made the audience aware of such investment's failure to yield high returns, in the long run, coupled with problems relating to liquidity.

Citing examples from her own life experience, she revealed her choice of making wise investments at an early stage in her life, which yielded her good returns years later. Therefore, she encouraged the students to look for good investment options in Mutual Funds and Capital Market. She stressed some crucial factors as choosing investment size, tenure of investment, earning potential of the investment, its liquidity to be kept in mind before making wise investments. She also advised the students to make informed choices when investing in Capital Market. She explained the difference between large, mid, and small-cap stocks and spoke about various stock market options for a wise investment.

Lastly, she cautioned students to be careful and not fall prey to dubious schemes by companies or groups who promise high and quick returns in their effort to attract investors. She concluded

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by encouraging students to concentrate on long-term results and make appropriate investments as needed and not by what is offered. She reiterated that students must start investing early in their career to get better returns later in life.

Resource person Mr. T.R Pandey spoke about Consumer Rights and created awareness among students about the Consumer Guidance Society of India(CGSI). Through a well-documented video, he explained the role of CGSI in educating the consumer about their rights, especially when faced with a situation where sellers offer them substandard adulterated foods or charge them exorbitant prices for goods. In some instances, policy claims are not settled at the right time. In real estate deals, there is a delay in getting ownership of the property in some cases. He concluded by asking the students to voice their opinion and concerns and approach CGSI and its various agencies to address their grievances and place their concerns and complaints. Overall, the webinar was very informative and useful. It provided the students the much-needed education about Financial Literacy and their Rights as Consumers under the governance of the Consumer Guidance Society of India.

WEBINAR ON WEBINAR ON "MANGROVES - DISTRIBUTION, ADAPTATIONS, BIODIVERSITY, AND CONSERVATION" ON DECEMBER 11, 2020

A webinar on "**Mangroves - Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation**" was jointly organized by the Department of Sociology and Department of Commerce under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell on 11th December 2020 in the college through Microsoft Teams platform. Around 125 students attended the webinar.

The Resource Person of the webinar was Mr. Hemant V. Karkhanis, Associate Manager, Mangrove Department, Construction Business Unit of Godrej, and Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. Mr. Hemant welcomed the students and apprised the students about Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation of Mangroves.

He gave insight into the distribution of Mangrove Forests through satellite images of Mangroves in Thane creek. He also highlighted and explained the growth and distribution of these forests across Maharashtra's eastern and western coast through a World Map picture

He explained to the audience the adaptations of Mangrove to their habitat. He discussed various varieties of mangroves seen in India, like River Mangroves and Red Mangroves. He explained

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their unique root system, which enables them to spread far and wide. He mentioned the Wax coating on their leaves, which prevents the leaves underwater from decay. He explained how the mother plant holds the new plant at a seed-stage for about two or three months before becoming independent and spreading its root.

He highlighted the various unobvious uses of Mangrove Forest to humankind. He spoke about its fruit, which is edible and used among the fisherfolk community. Its leaves are used as fodder for the cattle in various parts of Maharashtra and Gujarat. The wood of Mangrove forest is highly water-resistant and used by Fisherfolk Community for the construction of Boats. He spoke about its ability to absorb large amounts of pollutants from air and water, thereby creating a clean environment for the community.

He shared videos and images of various wildlife, birds, and insects for whom their presence is useful for feeding, breeding, and nesting. He educated the audience about the mangrove forest under the Coastal Regulatory Zone acquired by Godrej in 1940. The work on conservation carried out to date on the 2000 acres of land. He informed the students about the continuing work at Thane Creek Mangrove area wherein from 1998-2000, Godrej acquired 80 acres of the site and planted 20 lakh saplings of Mangrove.

He expressed concerns over neglecting this vast natural resource that is becoming extinct due to humanity's apathy. He discussed the measures taken by Godrej to educate and create awareness among the masses about mangroves. He spoke about Godrej's dedicated website to protect and preserve mangroves. He shared details about Godrej Mangrove Mobile App that is available in various languages to educate and creating awareness among the masses.

Overall, the webinar was very informative and useful. It provided the students the much-needed education about distribution, adaptations, biodiversity, and conservation of Mangroves.

GUEST LECTURE ON 'MUTUAL FUNDS' ON DECEMBER 15, 2020

Department of Commerce and Department of Sociology under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell, in association with National Institute of Securities Markets (Established by SEBI), organized a session on '**Mutual Funds**' for students on 15th December 2020 at 10.30 am. The session was hosted on the online platform Webex, and around 90 participants attended the session. The Resource Person for the session was **Mr. Gokulnath Raja, Business Development Manager from the National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM).**

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The theme of the session was on understanding the concept and working of Mutual Funds. Mr. Gokulnath Raja introduced the subject of Mutual Funds with the well-known idiom 'Don't put all eggs in one basket.' He spoke about the Mutual Fund as a basket where the money collected from many investors to invest in securities like stocks, bonds, etc., is kept. He highlighted that while investing, investors must not concentrate all efforts and resources in one area as one could lose everything, he likened it to all the eggs breaking if it is kept in one basket.

He explained the student's essential concepts of Mutual funds like Net Asset Value, Units, Open and Close-ended funds with illustrations and examples. He briefed the students on the functioning of Mutual Funds and introduced them to how mutual funds operate. He spoke about the different categories of Mutual Fund like Equity, Debt, Sector Equity, ELSS, and Liquid Funds and their characteristics.

In closing, he introduced the various certification courses offered by NSIM. He elaborated on the 26 courses offered at their institute. He informed the students that if they wish to be employed as a relationship manager in any Institution under Financial Markets, they will require this certification.

The session ended with students participating in College Level Quiz, which had Zonal and National Level Participation for those who qualified. Overall, the session seemed beneficial as it created awareness to the students on the topic of Mutual Funds.

Nappinai through Zoom platform and around 90 students attended the Workshop.

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The Resource Person of the Workshop was Advocate Noelle Ann Park – Advocate Bombay High Court specializing in Cyber Laws, Criminal Law (Corporate Criminal / White Collar Crime) & Writs and Ms. Marissa Borges, Head of Training and Program outreach, Red Dot Foundation.

This awareness workshop focused on increasing knowledge and awareness of Cyber Safety in digital spaces, focusing on Women and Child Safety Online to enhance security knowledge on the cyber domain.

Advocate Noelle Ann Park spoke about society's perception towards the female gender and the rising impact on crimes perpetuated towards women and children in the online domain. Through various case studies and real-life incidents among women and children, she explained how the wrong thought process has contributed to them being online victims and targets.

Advocate Noelle Ann Park explained to the students' various topics like Cyberbullying, Cyber Stalking, Impersonation online, Child pornography, Cyber threats through online chat rooms and online video games, Exposure to illegal and problematic content, Extortion online, Solicitation online, etc.

Advocate Noelle Ann Park also drew an association between the role of certain movies and social media contributing to the rise of depicting women in poor light and portraying them as victims of female gender.

The sessions were very interactive through student polls and case studies. Information on various laws enacted for the protection and safety of women and children were shared, which was very useful to the students. Understanding the relevant legislations and how they can receive justice about various crimes under different laws was also explained very well to students.

PANEL DISCUSSION ON “CEDAW: CONVENTION ON THE ELIMINATION OF ALL FORMS OF DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN” ON 14TH APRIL, 2021

B.M. Ruia Girls' College in collaboration with St. Arnold' College and Swami Vivekananda College organized a Panel Discussion on “**CEDAW: Convention on the elimination of all forms of Discrimination Against Women**” on 14th April, 2021.

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Convention on Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (CEDAW), adopted in 1979 by the UN General Assembly is an international bill of rights for Women consisting of a preamble and 30 articles.

It defines what constitutes Discrimination against women and sets up an agenda for national action to end such discrimination. India signed CEDAW in July 1980 and ratified it in 1993 with certain reservations.

CEDAW is very important for Youth today because they are the eyes and ears for monitoring whether women and girls rights are being protected. They are able to suggest government, how it can advance with respect to women rights in line with the convention. Three colleges of Mumbai – St. Arnold’s Night Degree College of Arts and Commerce, Andheri (East) (affiliated to University of Mumbai), Swami Vivekanand Night College of Arts and Commerce, Dombivali (East) (affiliated to University of Mumbai) and B.M. Ruia Girls’ College, Gamdevi (West) (affiliated to SNTD Women’s University) came together and organised a Panel Discussion on Online mode.

The programme commenced with Welcome and Introduction by **Prof. Sunita Sharma, Principal, St. Arnold’s Night Degree College; followed by Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak, Principal, B.M. Ruia Girls’ College, and Dr. Anuja N.Palsuledesai, Principal, Swami Vivekananda Night College of Arts and Commerce, briefing about their respective colleges.**

The Moderator of the Panel Discussion was Prof. Vibhuti Patel, Former Professor, TISS & SNTDWU, Mumbai. The Eminent Speakers of the Panel Discussion were Professor Pam Rajput, Professor, Department cum Centre for Women’s Studies and Development, Panjab University, Dr. S.M. 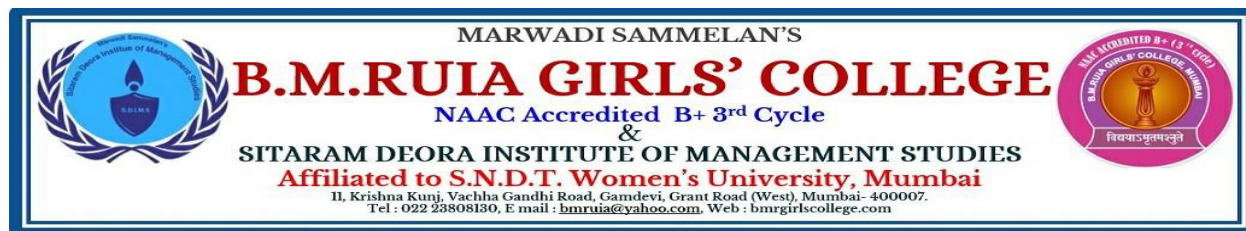

C. Marathi Bhasha Sanvardhan Panadharwada

- As per the guidelines received through circular regarding celebrating ‘Marathi Bhasha Sanvardhan Pandharwada’ from the Government of Maharashtra, on 22nd January, 2021, as part of ‘Marathi Bhasha Sanvardhan Pandharwada,’ English Core Component Course organised a screening of Kavita Datir and Amit Sonawane directed National and International Award-winning Marathi short documentary 'Babai' as a Class Activity. The screening was held from 9.20 am onwards. 23 students of B. Com I class were present for this screening. D. Language Skills Activities

1. Listening

Learners from all six classes were asked to listen to all the videos screened in their classes attentively to make them practice attentive listening. So, all the movies and YouTube videos screenings were a part of listening skill activities.

Screened the trailer of the film based short story "Pinti' Sabun" by Sanjay Khati on 5th April, 2021, a video explaining the short story ‘Miriam's Letter’ by Dhumketu on 5th May, 2021. Screened a short-animated film based on Ruskin Bond's short story “The Wind on Haunted Hill” on 1st July, 2021 as a listening skill activity in B.A I class.

Reading and explanation followed by a screening of a short film based on the short story “The Meeting Pool” by Ruskin Bond held on 13th July, 2020, an

introduction to the short story 'The Meeting Pool' in faculty's voice was played in the class on 19th July, 2020, and listening to two news reviews activity followed by writing the new words and their meanings the learners learnt from these two reviews in the comments box and their notebooks on 3rd Dec, 2020 and YouTube audios consisting of the poems by Robert Frost and Rudyard Kipling as a part of the listening skills activity on 10th June, 2021 were conducted in B.A III Class.

2. Speaking

Phonetics activity was conducted in B.A I class. Students were taught the 44 sounds in English along with their pronunciation and examples the students were able to pronounce the words correctly with the help of phonetics transcription given in the dictionary. This exercise and pronunciation help them to improve spoken English. Screened the YouTube videos 'Introduction to the sounds of English' on 10th Dec, 2020, 'Plosive Sounds of English' 10th Dec 2020, 'Sounds of English, 44 Phonemes and Pronunciation' on 22nd Dec, 2020 and 'Sounds of English: Listen and Repeat' on 23rd Dec, 2020. B.A.I students were also taught punctuation marks in detail to make them understand the importance of punctuation marks.

Screened YouTube videos about 'Introducing Yourself' on 10th Dec, 2020 followed by 'introducing self, others and guest' and 'vote of thanks' activity by students. Screened a video related to 'Public Speeches' and 'Short Speeches' in English on 5th July, 2021 and explaining how to give a 'Welcome Speech' and a 'Formal Vote of Thanks' on 7th July, 202 followed by a mock vote of thanks activity by the students for the different programs like 'Annual Day Celebration', 'Sports Day', cultural programs like 'Self Composed Poetry Recitation and Competition' was conducted in B.A II class as a teaching aid to an oral explanation of the Spoken English prescribed topics.

Screened videos related to the Speaking Skills topic of your syllabus "Telephone Etiquettes" on 11th December, 2020, Formal and Informal Telephone Conversation on 14th Dec, 2020, Motivational videos entitled 'No arms, no legs, no worries', Fears, and A Short Motivational Video to motivate the learners to speak

in English on 26th April, 2021 and a video consisting of Simple everyday Spoken English on 2nd July, 2021 in B.A III class as Speaking Skills Activities.

3. Reading

The learners from all the six classes were asked to read the prescribed short stories, notes based on speaking and writing skill topics, Business Communication theory loudly in the class and the faculty corrected their pronunciation, punctuation, stress, intonation related mistakes on the spot.

4. Writing

Writing requires making choices. We can help students most by teaching them how to see and make choices when working with ideas. We can introduce students to the process of generating and sorting ideas by teaching them how to use exercises to build ideas. With an understanding of how to discover and arrange ideas, they will have more success in getting their ideas onto the page in clear prose.

Through critical thinking exercises, students move from a vague or felt sense about course material to a place where they can make explicit choices about how words represent their ideas and how they might best arrange them. While some students may not recognize some of these activities as “writing,” they may see that doing this work will help them do the thinking that leads to easier, stronger papers.

The teaching of writing skill topics was supplemented by screenings of YouTube videos explaining the topic 'Information Transfer' on 5th November, 2020, 'Email Writing' on 12th January, 2021, explaining 'Formal and Informal Letter Writing' on 13th January, 2021, explaining 'Informal Email Writing' on 9th February, 2021, on the topic 'Story Writing' on 22nd June, 2021 and on the topic 'Narrator' on 23rd June, 2021 in B.A I class and related to 'Writing Guided Paragraphs' on 23rd June, 2021 in B.Com I class as teaching aids to notes and oral explanation of the topics in the class.

The teaching of writing skill topics was enhanced by screenings of YouTube videos explaining arranging a paragraph from the jumbled up sentences on 20th January, 2021, explaining the topic 'Report Writing' on 10th May, 2021, explaining 'Report Writing: Advanced Skills' on 17th May, 2021, 'Enquiry Letters' on 23rd, June, 2021

in B.A II classes as teaching aids to notes and oral explanation of the topics in the class.

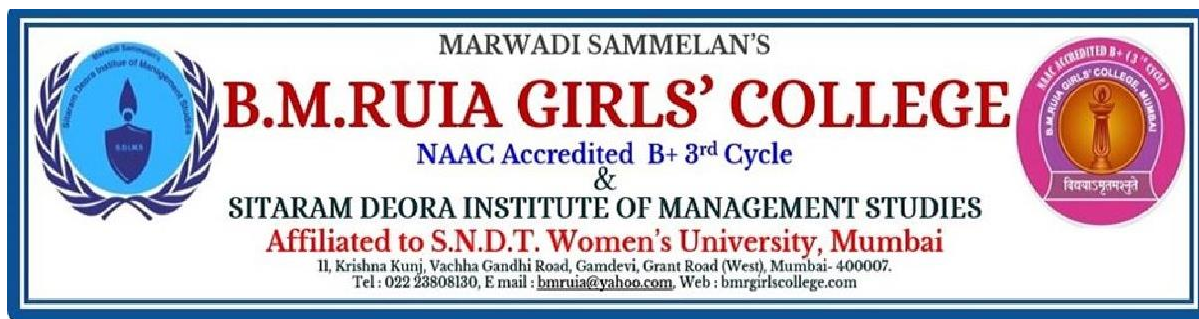
5. 'Bride and Prejudice'

WEBINAR ON WEBINAR ON "MANGROVES - DISTRIBUTION, ADAPTATIONS, BIODIVERSITY, AND CONSERVATION" ON DECEMBER 11, 2020

A webinar on "**Mangroves - Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation**" was jointly organized by the Department of Sociology and Department of Commerce under the aegis of Internal Quality Assurance Cell on 11th December 2020 in the college through Microsoft Teams platform. Around 125 students attended the webinar.

The Resource Person of the webinar was Mr. Hemant V. Karkhanis, Associate Manager, Mangrove Department, Construction Business Unit of Godrej, and Boyce Mfg. Co. Ltd. Mr. Hemant welcomed the students and apprised the students about Distribution, Adaptations, Biodiversity, and Conservation of Mangroves.

He gave insight into the distribution of Mangrove Forests through satellite images of Mangroves in Thane creek. He also highlighted and explained the growth and distribution of these forests across Maharashtra's eastern and western coast through a World Map picture

He explained to the audience the adaptations of Mangrove to their habitat. He discussed various varieties of mangroves seen in India, like River Mangroves and Red Mangroves. He explained their unique root system, which enables them to spread far and wide. He mentioned the Wax coating on their leaves, which prevents the leaves underwater from decay. He explained how the mother plant holds the new plant at a seed-stage for about two or three months before becoming independent and spreading its root.

He highlighted the various unobvious uses of Mangrove Forest to humankind. He spoke about its fruit, which is edible and used among the fisherfolk community. Its leaves are used as fodder for the cattle in various parts of Maharashtra and Gujarat. The wood of Mangrove forest is highly water-resistant and used by Fisherfolk Community for the construction of Boats. He spoke about its ability to absorb large amounts of pollutants from air and water, thereby creating a clean environment for the community.

He shared videos and images of various wildlife, birds, and insects for whom their presence is useful for feeding, breeding, and nesting. He educated the audience about the mangrove forest

under the Coastal Regulatory Zone acquired by Godrej in 1940. The work on conservation carried out to date on the 2000 acres of land. He informed the students about the continuing work at Thane Creek Mangrove area wherein from 1998-2000, Godrej acquired 80 acres of the site and planted 20 lakh saplings of Mangrove.

He expressed concerns over neglecting this vast natural resource that is becoming extinct due to humanity's apathy. He discussed the measures taken by Godrej to educate and create awareness among the masses about mangroves. He spoke about Godrej's dedicated website to protect and preserve mangroves. He shared details about Godrej Mangrove Mobile App that is available in various languages to educate and creating awareness among the masses.

Overall, the webinar was very informative and useful. It provided the students the much-needed education about distribution, adaptations, biodiversity, and conservation of Mangroves.

- **National Webinar on “Role of Extension Activities and Sports”, 17th May, 2021**

Student Welfare Committee in association with Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Marwadi Sammelan’s B. M. Ruia Girls’ College and Sitaram Deora Institute of Management Studies Affiliated to S.N.D.T. Women’s University, Mumbai, organised Day 9 of National Webinar Series on “National Education Policy 2020: Prospects and Challenges in Higher Education”, on May 17, 2021, from 11.30 am onwards, entitled “Role of Extension Activities and Sports.”

This webinar series aims to bring out a synthesis among connoisseurs across diverse disciplines in Social Sciences and Humanities to develop a vibrant understanding of National Education Policy 2020 and its possible influence on the Higher Education Establishments in India.

The eminent resource persons of the Day 9 Webinar were Dr. Nishan Singh Deol, Professor and Head, Department of Physical Education, Punjabi University, Patiala, Punjab and Dr. Atul Salunkhe, State Liaison Officer, Officer on Special Duty, NSS Cell, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai.

The webinar was inaugurated with the welcome address delivered by Dr. Kashyap Ganatra, Assistant Professor of Commerce. In his welcome address, he stated that the need to integrate Extension Activities and Sports in education is well recognized in New Education Policy, 2020 as it serves to foster holistic development by promoting the physical and psychological wellbeing of the learners. This was followed by College Prayer sung by Ms. Shruti Ranade, Associate Professor of Psychology, the Counsellor of College Counselling Cell ‘Mantrana’ and an In-charge of Cultural Activities, in her melodious voice. The prayer was followed by SNTD Women’s University song.

Day 9 of the National Webinar Series was compered by Dr Kashyap Ganatra. He illuminated that Extension Activities and Sports are a very good way

for students to relate and learn various aspects of life. In this way the concepts become relevant and the overall communication becomes meaningful. There are students with different abilities and strengths. Therefore, it is a very good idea to give students options to choose what they feel they want to do. Extension activities like Cultural Events, Physical Education, NSS, NCC, Sports, etc. are very important for both physical and mental health. They help in developing skills such as self-initiative, self-direction, self-discipline, self-responsibility, collaboration, teamwork, leadership quality, citizenship, etc. They also contribute to enhancing the aesthetic, artistic, historical, intellectual and socio-cultural development of the students. As NEP notes Sports integration learning will be undertaken in classroom transactions to help students adopt fitness as a lifelong attitude and to achieve related life skills along with the level of fitness and its emphasis on the 'Fit India Movement.'

Dr. Kashyap's welcome address was followed by the Principal, Dr. Santosh Kaul Kak's address. In her Bi-lingual (English and Hindi) address she rigorously expounded that the NEP 2020 includes several key points that are instrumental for the holistic development of the child. She expressed her worry over the news of suicides of the students after the results of every board and competitive examinations and stated that most importantly dealing with failure is an imperative life skill that builds self-belief and mental strength. Sports and other extension activities are team-based activities that inculcate comradery and team spirit. Underlining the importance of integrated development of learners, Governor Manoj Sinha while addressing the Governor's conference on NEP suggested that extra-curricular activities such as NSS, NCC, Sports, Music, etc. need to be made part of the curriculum and students should be given credit for participating in these activities. She added that Honourable Education Minister Shri. Pokhariyal ji has highlighted that the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has a superpower of self-motivated youth of India associated with various youth programmes. Youth, as NEP minutes can contribute significantly in creating

awareness about NEP 2020 at the grass-root level. The ambassadors of NEP 2020 hope that the volunteers from NSS, NCC and coordinators of ‘Unnat Bharat Abhiyan’ will play a crucial role in the successful implementation of NEP 2020. She also added that the graded study of Sports and Sports specialized subjects at the Higher Education Level will significantly enhance the professionalism of our institutions and will facilitate our quest for international success and becoming Vishwaguru again. Most importantly it would help change the traditional mindset of academicians, families, students in a meaningful way and we would finally stop saying what we have been listening to since childhood “Kheloge, Kudoge Banoge Kharab, Padhoge, Likhoge Banoge Nawab.”

The Principal’s address was followed by the First Session. The Resource Person of the first session Dr. Nishan Singh Deol, Professor and Head, Department of Physical Education, Punjabi University, Patiala, Punjab, in his bilingual address (English and Hindi) entitled “National Education Policy 2020 and Sports” quoted Mahatma Gandhi at the outset: “Education is the all-round drawing out of best in the child and man- body, mind and spirit.” Followed by screening a scene from the film ‘3 Idiots’ to point out the importance of avoiding the rat race of marks and giving a thought to learning something new. According to him, our citizens live in a voluntary ignorance and reek of cowardice and therefore, India is 133rd amongst the 195 countries in the world in the context of the Human Development Index. He continued by focusing on the Four Pillars of Learning including ‘Learning to Know, Learning to Live Together, Learn to Be, Learn to do’ which aim at making learners academically, socially and emotionally competent. Evolution of National Education Policies in India in 1968, 1986, 1992, 2005, 2016, 2017, showcases the transition and focus areas of each policy considering the necessity of inclusivity of all sections of society. In the case of School Education, the NEP 2020 proposes to focus upon Early childhood education, Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, Curriculum and Pedagogy, Universal Access, Equitable and Inclusive Education, Teachers and School

Governance while in Higher Education three types of Institutions are based on a difference in focus in which all will be of high quality: 1. Focus on World Class Research, 2. Focus on high-quality teaching across disciplines, 3. Focus on high-quality teaching and additional focus will be on High-Quality Liberal Education. He emphasized that the energized, engaged, and capable faculty is the need of an hour and National Research Foundation will help faculty to undertake quality research. He stressed the importance of flexibility in choosing the vocational courses and Indian languages which would result in the holistic development of the learners. He quoted from a recent paper in a medical journal which suggests that doctors should replace teachers and force students in 20 minutes exercise a day would definitely change the present scenario “Physical Education Down, Obesity Up” to “Physical Education Up, Obesity Down.” In his view, the issues of physical education are National Policies and Practices, The Curriculum and the Resources. He further stated that even at the school level there is a National Policy of physical education but the laws are not followed, the programme is not properly carried out, lack of infrastructure and lack of time for teaching cause the students to lose interest in physical education and therefore, there is a need of physical literacy which would effect into children being physically active and making healthy choices. While concluding his address he listed the dos and don’ts for the parents and teachers which will help in enhancing physical literacy in society.

The Resource Person of the Second Session, Dr. Atul Salunkhe, State Liaison Officer, Officer on Special Duty, NSS Cell, Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai at the outset of his bilingual address (English and Hindi) entitled “Role of Extension Activities in National Education Policy 2020” specified the fact that India has a long tradition of holistic and multidisciplinary learning at the universities, schools and colleges. Earlier, universities like Takshashila and Nalanda combined various subjects in the syllabus. The ancient literary work such as Banbhatta in his “Kadambari”

describes a good education as a piece of knowledge as the art which is called as 64 arts that includes singing, painting, chemistry, carpentry, medicine, soft skills etc. We need to focus on how students get integrated with humanities, passion for the nation, creativity, innovations, critical thinking, problem-solving ability, communication skills, etc. and here extension activities play an important role. He cited a few examples of path-breaking personalities who are the products of Maharashtra NSS including the former Vice-Chancellor of University of Mumbai Dr. Rajan Velukar, Shweta Umbare, a second winner of National Youth Parliament of the year 2019-20, Dr. Sanjay Chakane, the Principal of Indapur College whose college has produced sanitiser and distributed it among the needy, Mr. Popatrao Pawar, a Padmashri Awardee, a Sarpanch of the Ideal Village Hiwarebazar, and Dr. Sayali Kamat, a student from Dental College who won the National Summer Internship Programme. Other examples he cited were Nilima Mishra, one of the volunteers of NSS who has won the Ramon Magsaysay Award for her work in the field of Self-Help Groups and Mallinath Kalshetty, IAS Officer while working as a District Collector at Nandurbar, succeeded in making all the schools tobacco-free. He underlined the need for college and extension activities which the parents and students have realized greatly in the Pandemic situation as the parents are unable to handle their pupils at home. He explicated on the role and significance of extension activities conducted through NSS, NCC, Sports, Nature Club, Debating and Elocution Competitions, Theatre Clubs, etc. and described various objectives of integrating extra-curricular activities in the education system which range from cultural integration, building social skills, building a resume, earning career experience. He enumerated the benefits of extra-curricular activities together with learning new skills, boosting academic performance, improving time management, impressing universities. The most popular extracurricular activities in his view are Sports Teams, Part Time Job or Volunteering, Student Body Positions, Writing/Student Journalism, Culture-based Clubs, The Arts etc. While concluding his glimpses he clarified the FAQs

regarding the extracurricular and extension activities and elucidated the Role and Impact of NSS in the present Covid-19 Pandemic counting raising awareness, communicating accurate information, countering rumours, providing needed services, liaising with the government during an emergency, planning an action for the Pandemic situation, mask making, helping in community kitchens, police mitra, blood donation, making sanitisers etc.

The First Resource Person was introduced by Dr. Usha Kiran Tiwari, Head and Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology and NSS Programme Officer and the Second Resource Person was introduced by Dr. Hemlata Masiwal, Assistant Professor of Sociology specifying their expertise and notable contribution to academics.

Question and Answer Session was conducted by Ms. Swati Vaidya, Head and Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, RUSA Coordinator and M.A Economics Programme Coordinator. This session was based on wide-ranging questions of participants posted in the chat boxes of Google Meet and YouTube Live Streaming, addressed to the Resource Persons.

Live feedback on the webinar was provided by Dr. Anita Singh, Assistant Professor, Department of Sports and Physical Education, Gopichand Arya Mahila College, Abhor, Punjab.

A formal Vote of Thanks was proposed by Ms. Swati Vaidya.

At the end of the webinar, everyone rose as the 'National Anthem' was played. The Feedback Link was provided after National Anthem in the chat boxes of Google Meet and YouTube Live Streaming and the e-certificates of the participants were emailed to them.

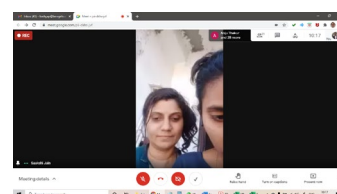
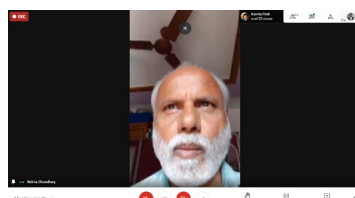
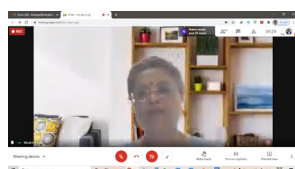
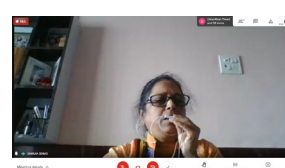
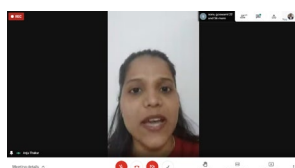
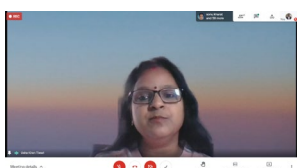
REPORT: 2020-21
