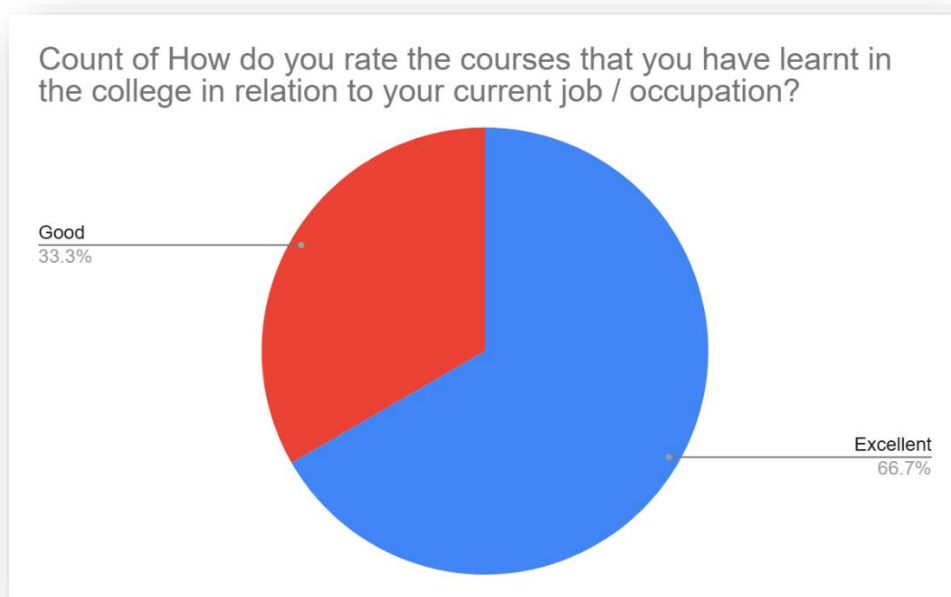


Alumni Feedback Analysis

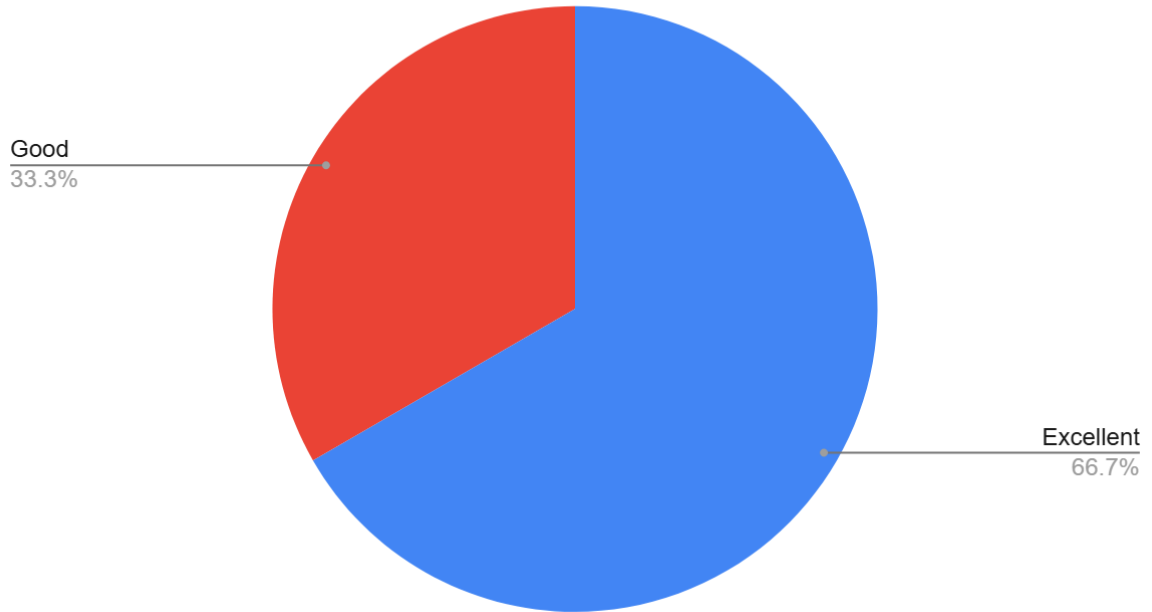
Academic Year 2019-20

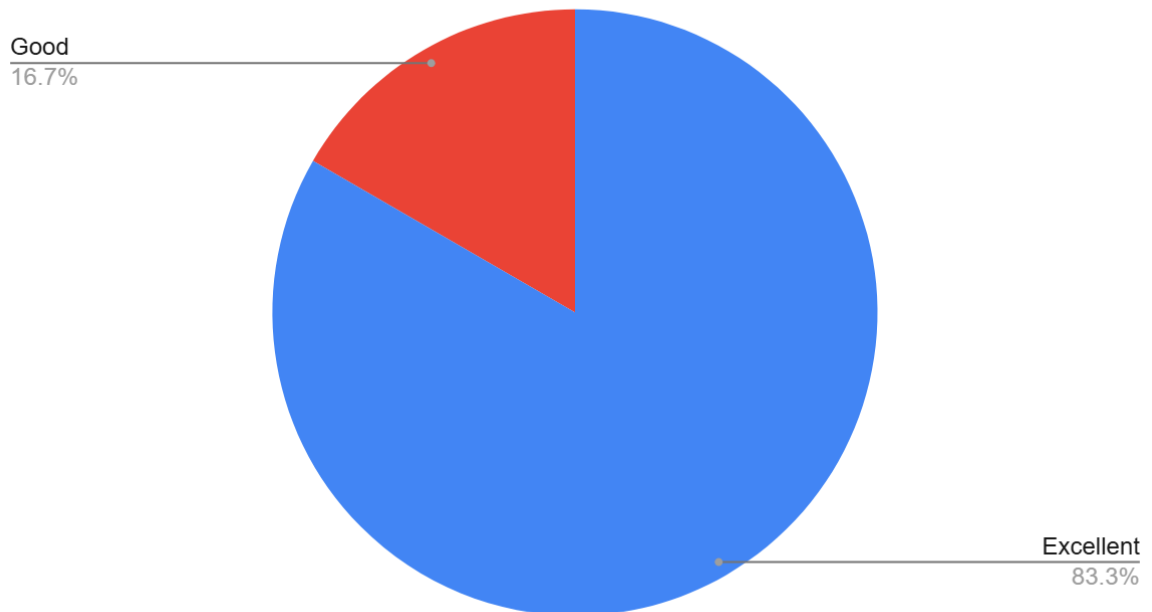

4. **Appreciation for Faculty and Learning Environment:** Alumni commended the teaching-learning process and the faculty's active involvement in their overall growth and development.



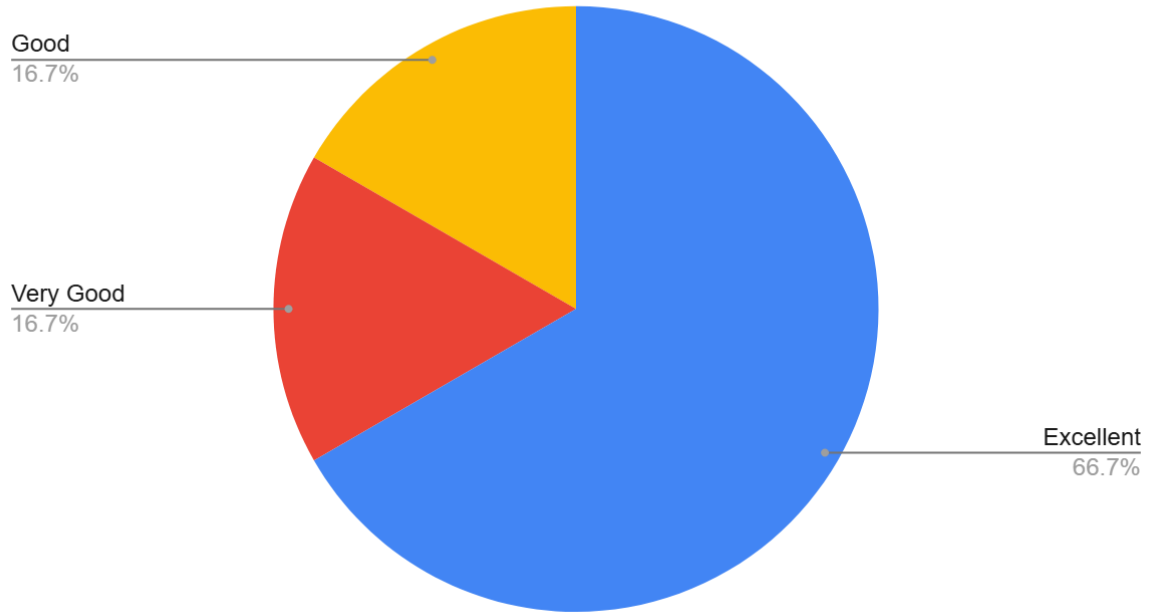
Count of Infrastructure and computer facilities



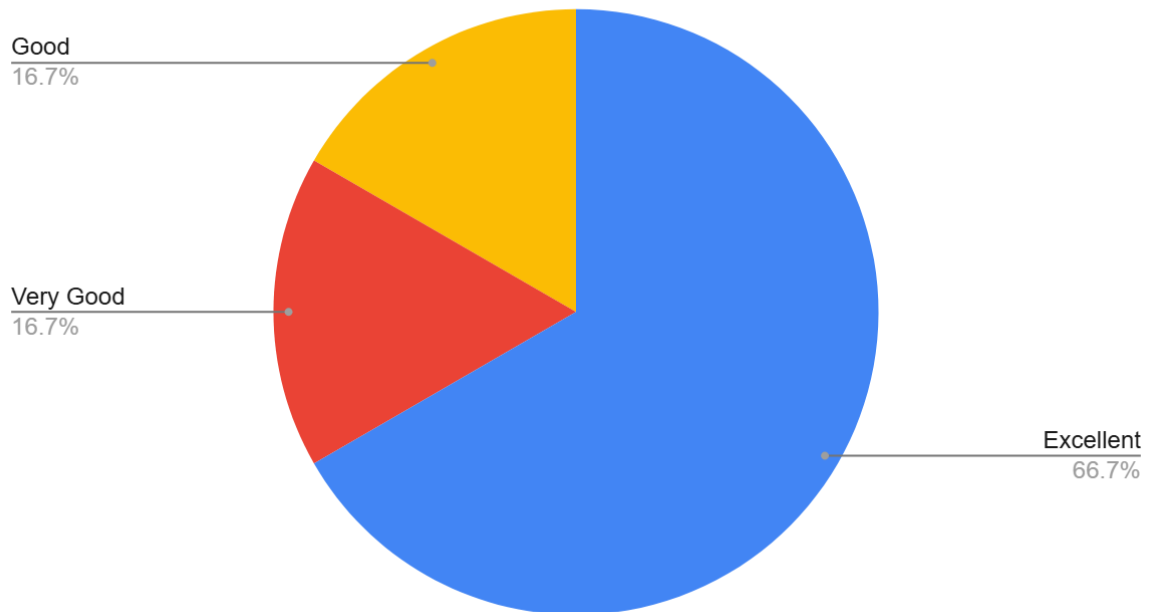
Count of Performance of your Faculty (Teachers)



Count of Canteen Facilities

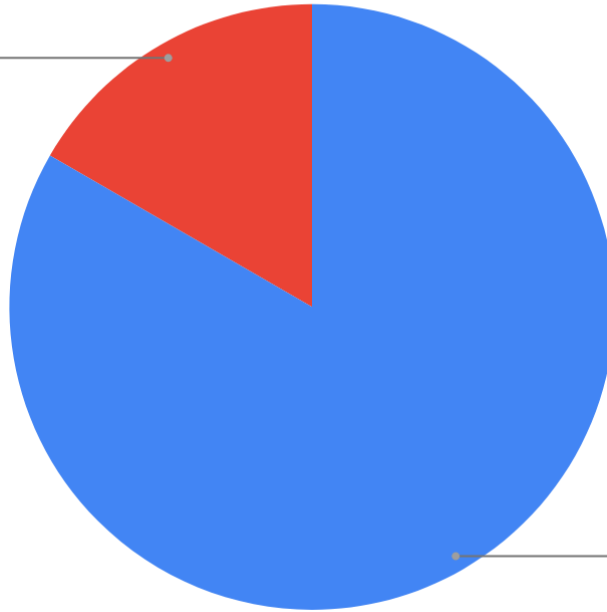

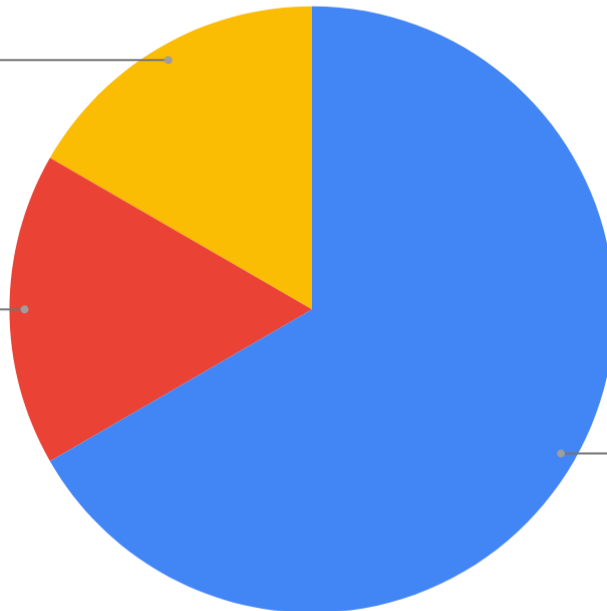

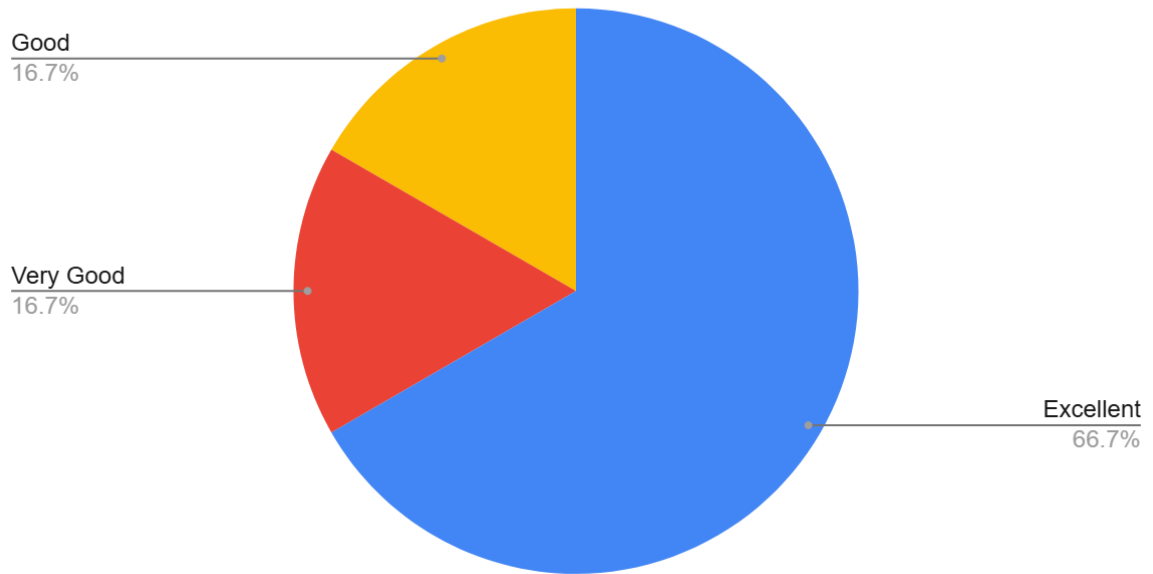

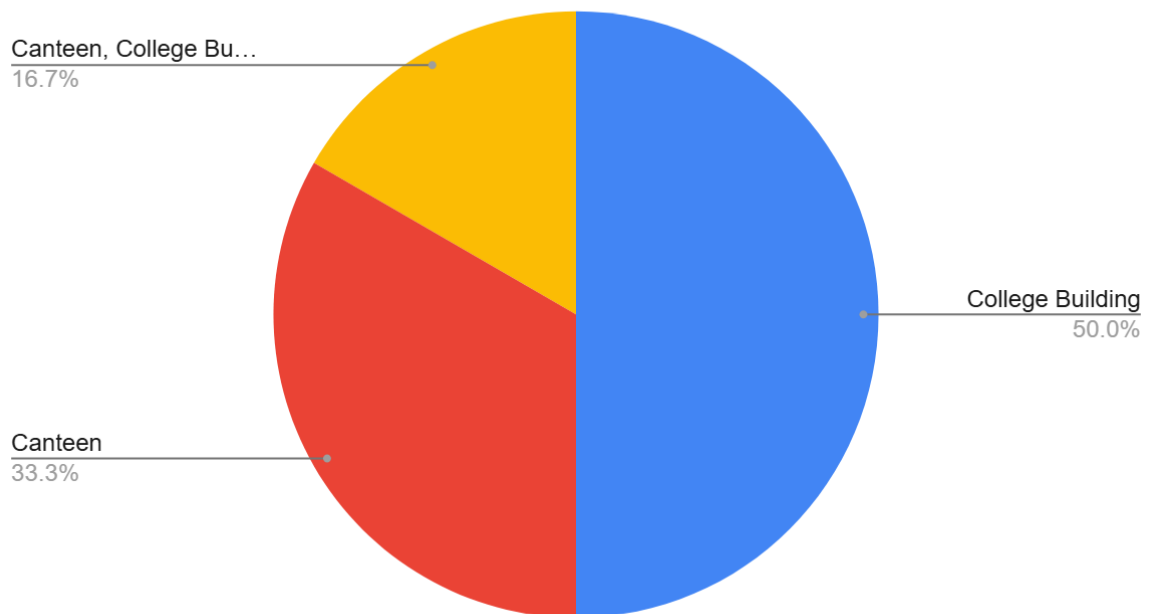

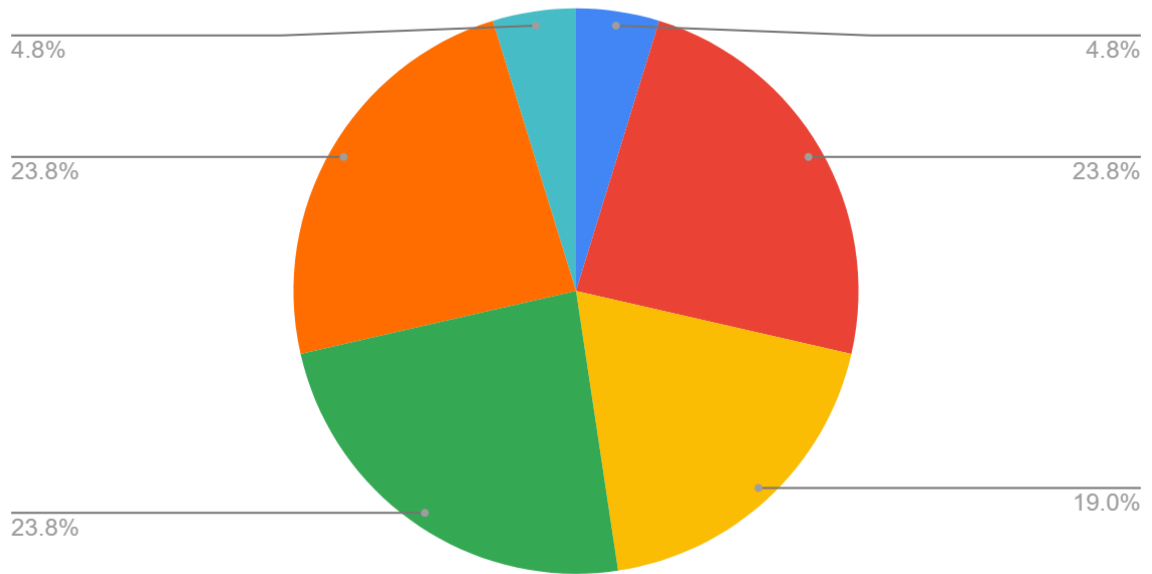
Count of Development activities organised by the College for overall growth



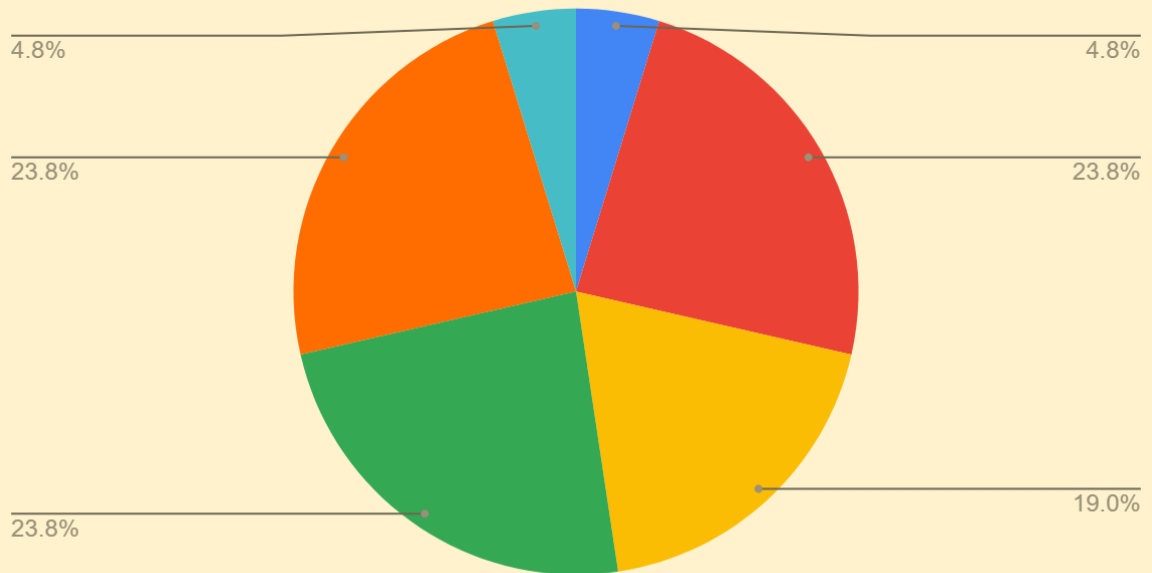
Count of What should improve according to you in college?



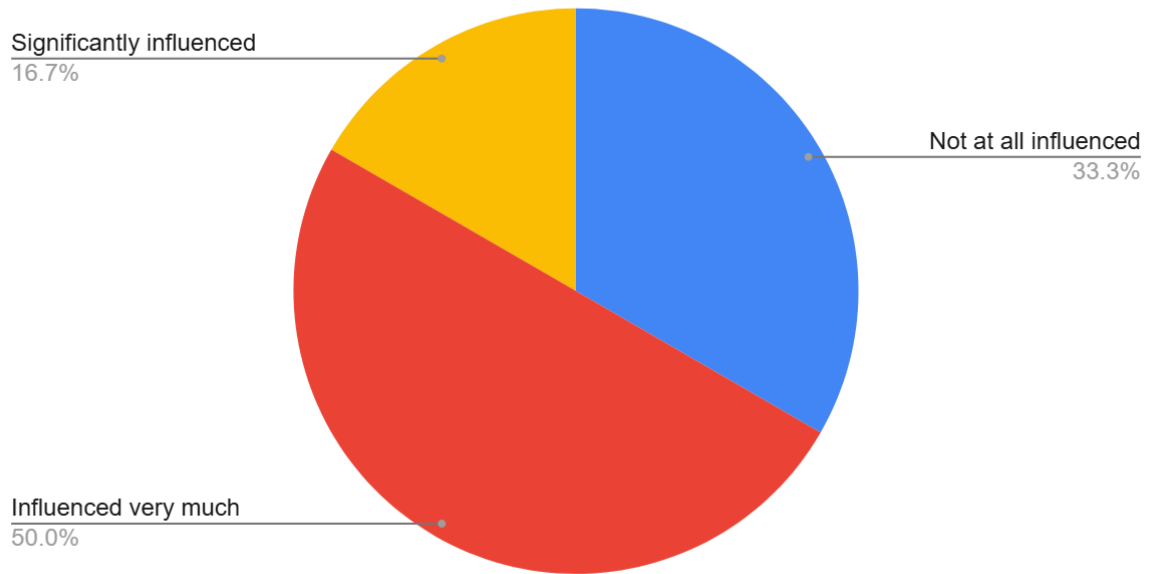
To what extent you think your personality was developed in college?



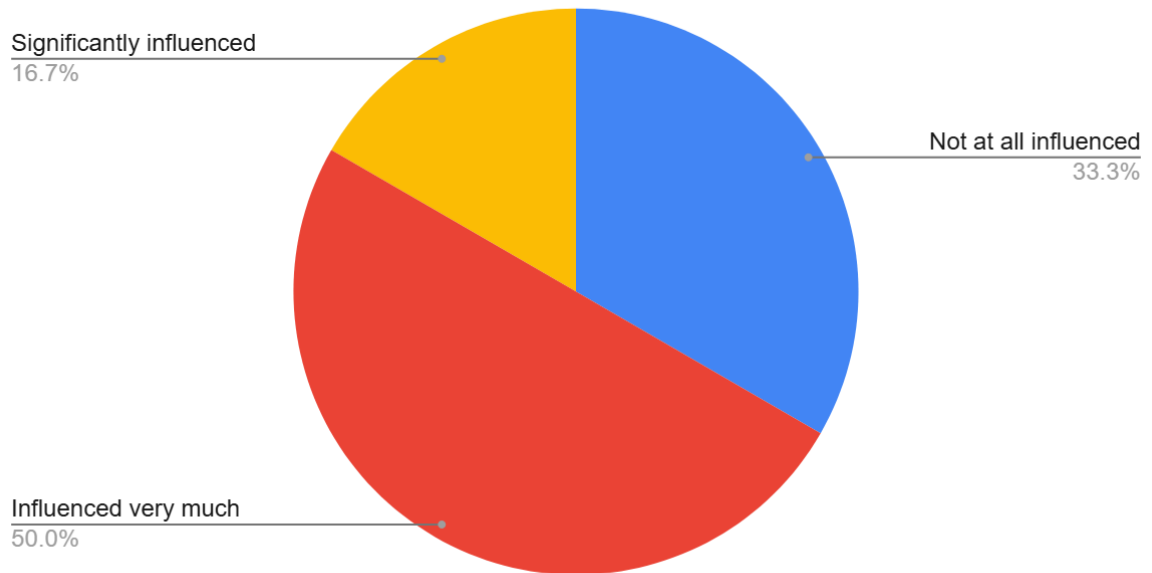
To what extent you think your personality was developed in college?



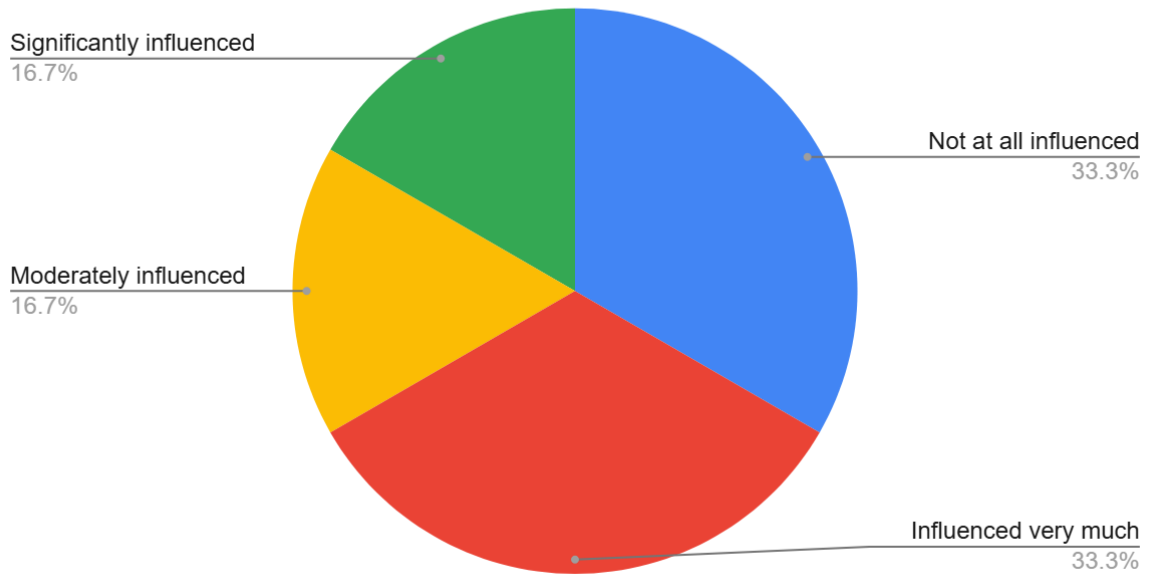
Count of To what extent you think your personality was developed in college?
