- Alumni appreciated the college's contribution, with the majority selecting Very Good or higher.

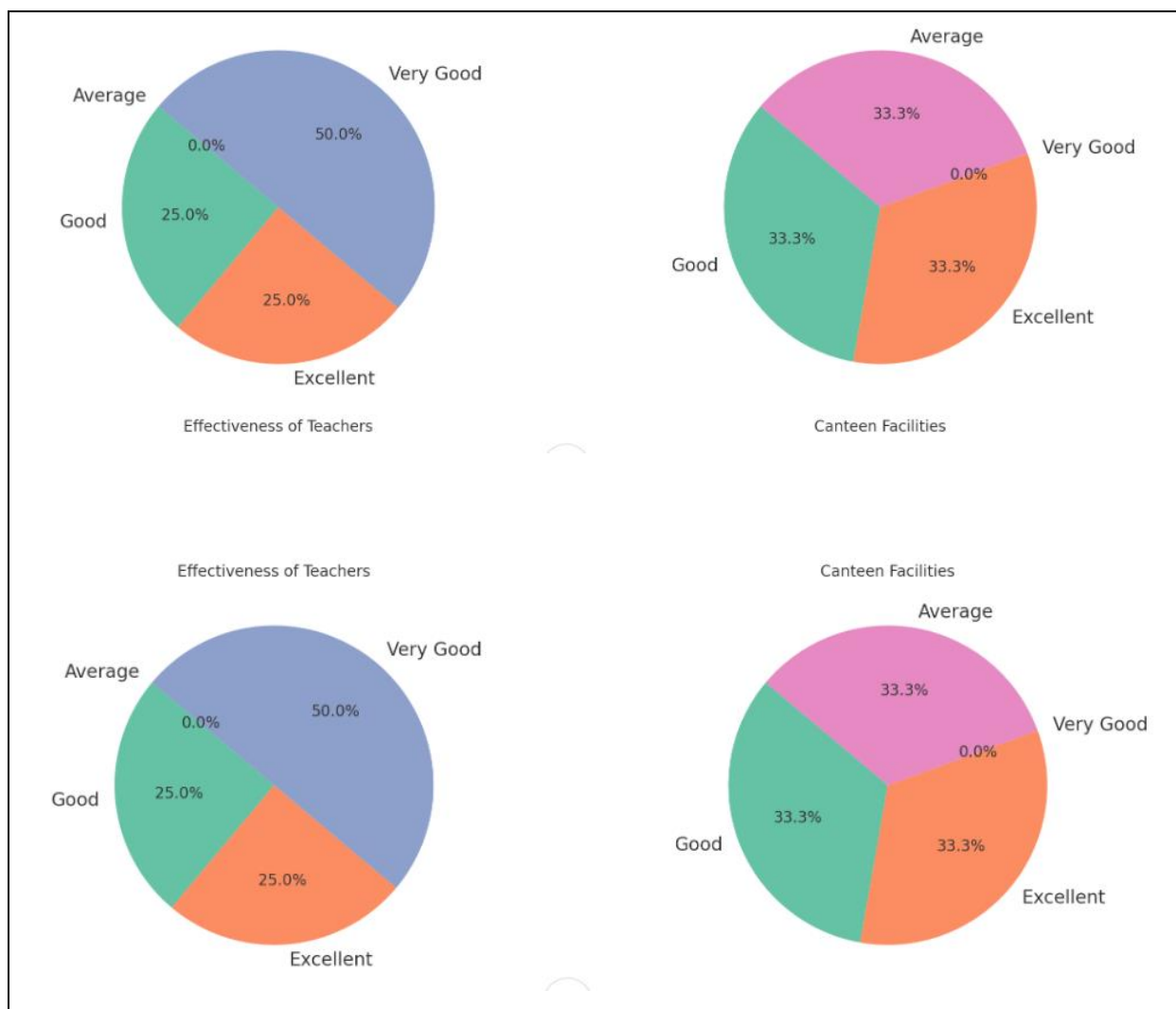
9. Projects/Assignments Enhancing ICT Skills

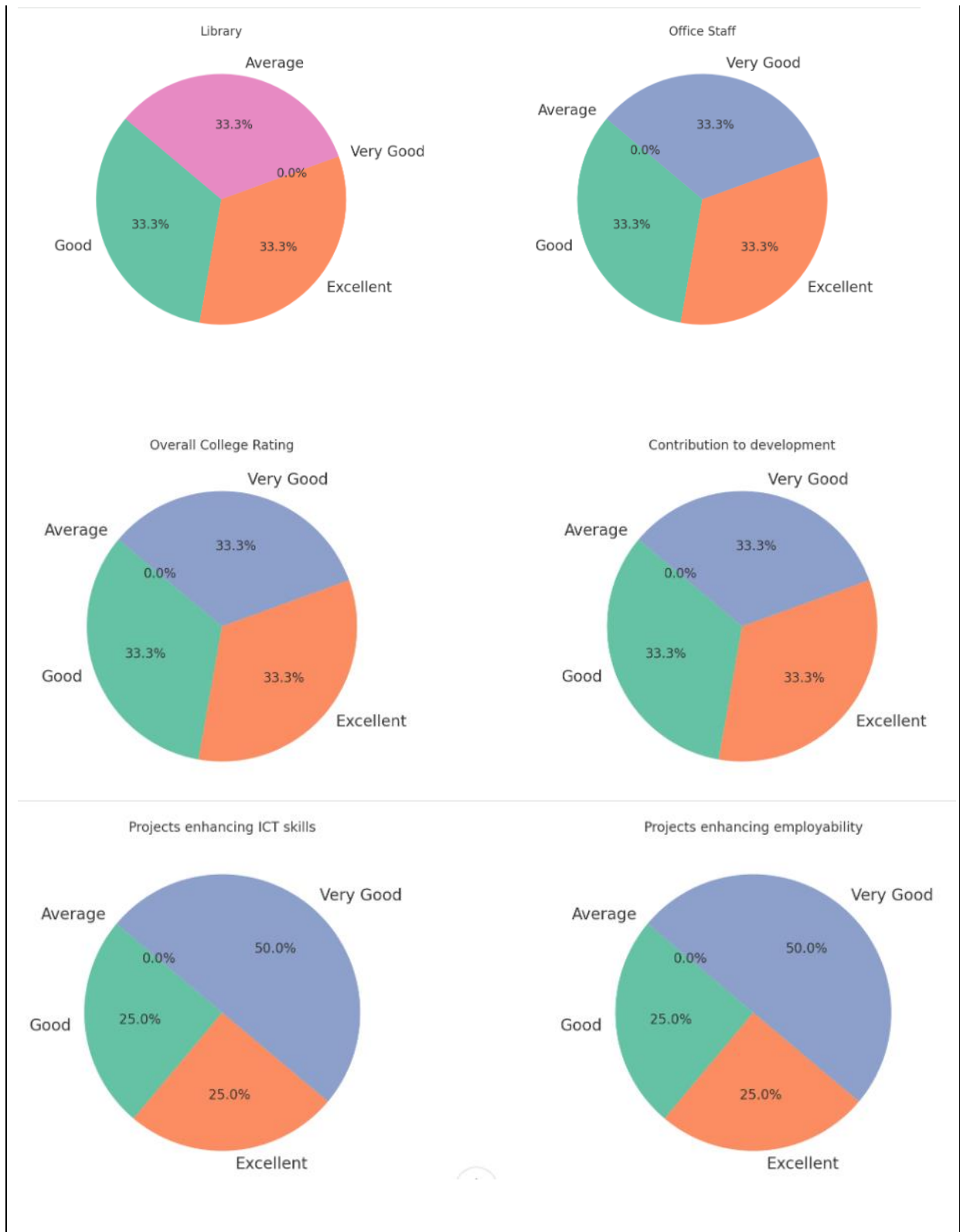
- Strong feedback with Very Good and Excellent ratings, highlighting effective skill-building.
